ORDER

In the Government Order read as first paper above Government have prescribed a pass in the Malayalam Typewriting (KGTR-Lower) or its equivalent as additional qualification for recruitment to the post of English typist in Government Service.

2. In the Government Order read as second paper above orders were issued exempting ex-servicemen from Malayalam Typewriting qualification for recruitment to the post of typists (English) in Government service with the condition that persons so appointed will acquire that qualification before the completion of probation.

- 3. In the Government Order read as third paper above, the Ex-servicemen Typists (English) in the NGC Department who have completed the age of 45 were exempted from passing Malayalam Typewriting (KGTE-Lower). The Registrar of High Court in the letter read above has forwarded a proposal for extension of this exemption to the Ex-servicemen employed as Typist (English) in other Government Departments also.
 - 4. Government have examined the matter in detail in consultation with the Public Service Commission and are pleased to order that re-employed Ex-Servicemen Lower Division Typist (English) in Government Departments who have completed the age of 45 years will be exempted from passing Malayalam K. G. T. E. (Lower).
